
When does one need an export permit to take cultural objects abroad?

If the heritage asset is to be exported permanently then make sure before that it doesn't belong to the category specified in Article 51 § 4, which means that it is not on the National Heritage Assets Register

Check the object against the database of stolen cultural goods www.skradzionezabytki.pl

Ask if the object has documentation regarding its history

Ask for a certificate of authenticity

Ask about its country of origin

Enquire regarding recent conservation works, which have been carried on the object. In particular the nature and author of these works

Enquire, regarding the identity of the previous owner where possible

Make sure that a receipt is issued correctly, this should have at the least a short description of the article, the date of purchase and full details of the seller

Keep all documentation obtained, In case you have any doubts regarding the past of the object
